The day made their report of the Court after hearing evidence, ordering the payment of Thirty dollars, in addition to the Ninety dollars already paid.

✓ It being suggested to the Court that the Lands aforesaid as given to Mary & Hobson, widow of D. J. Hobson, died by the Commissioner appointed at the February Term 1877, are excessive in value, being greatly more than its value, of all the lands of which the said D. J. Hobson died seized. It is Ordered that the said lands be re-committed to the said Commissioner to act, R. B. Sibley, C. W. Wilson, B. C. Dowd, John G. Jones & John Hobson, with instructions to assess the same and return to Court together with a statement under oath of the valuation put by them upon the property and upon which the aforesaid is founded.

And the Court doth further decree that David H. Kindred, (Trustee) promises to execute the Deed of Trust made by Govt Darden and Caroline his wife, the 13th of November, 1878, according to its terms. That he sell the real estate therein conveyed for Costs, after twenty day public Notice, of time & place, by advertisements posted at his usual public place in Southampton, and by Counsel of parties, to said Kindred is not required to execute and land until the further Order of this Court. And the said Kindred will report his proceedings under this Order to this Court.

Read, or any two of them, shall examine the route for said Road, and report to the Court the convenience & inconveniences that will result to individuals as well as to the public if such road be opened as proposed, and especially whether any yard, orchard, garden or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken.
