It is now is this day granted by Wm. F. Vick, William Vain, Top & Justice, John C. Driscoll, C. C. Whitfield, M. L. Whelan, & John F. Glavin, an application to sell by Retail only in quantities up to five gallons at any one time to any one individual, Wine, Brandy Spirit, Most Liqueurs, Cider, or any mixture thereof at their several places of business in this County, which shall not be drunk, within the town or City or village where sold, but shall be delivered to the purchasers as bottles, jugs, demijohns, or other vessels to be removed therefrom, for the period beginning on the 1st day of May 1879, & expiring on the 30th day of April 1880, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicants are fit persons, and that their places of business are suitable & convenient, and the applicants having executed a bond as required by law with good Security payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty of Five hundred dollars, Conditioned for a faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia entitled, "An act imposing a tax and prescribing the mode of collecting the same on the privilege of selling Wine, Brandy Spirit, or Most Liqueurs, within the limits of the Commonwealth for the Support of the Government, and to pay the interest on the public debt, approved March 30th 1877, as amended by the Act approved April 2^d 1877, and as amended by the Act approved April 1st 1879."

It is now is this day granted to M. L. Whelan, and John F. Glavin, an application to sell by the Drinker, in quantities of not more than One half pint, not to be taken away from the place of delivery but to be drunk at the place where sold, Wine, Brandy Spirit, Most Liqueurs, Cider, or any mixture thereof, at their places of business in this County, for the period beginning on the 1st day of May 1879, and expiring on the 30th day of April 1880, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicants are fit persons, and that their places of business are suitable and convenient, and the applicants having executed a bond as required by law with good Security payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia in a penalty of Five hundred dollars, Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, entitled, "An act imposing a tax and prescribing the mode of collecting the same, on the privilege of selling Wine, Brandy Spirit or Most Liqueurs within the limits of the Commonwealth for the Support of the Government, and to pay the interest on the public debt," approved March 30th 1877, as amended by the Act approved April 2^d 1877, and as amended by the Act approved April 1st 1879."
