A license is this day granted E. J. Gardner, at his application to sell by Retail only in quantities up to five gallons, at any time to any one individual, Wine, Ardent Spirits, Most Liqueurs, Cider or any Neutral liquor, which shall not be drunk within the said no^t County where he is, but shall be delivered to the purchaser in barrels or jugs, demijohns, or other vessels, to be removed therefrom, and also to sell by the Drinker or quantity of not more than One half pint, not to be taken away from the place of delivery but to be drunk at the place where sold. Wine, Ardent Spirits, Liqueurs, Cider, or any Neutral liquor at his house in the Town of Jericho for the period beginning on the 1st day of May 1879, expiring on the shortest day of April 1880, the Court being fully satisfied that the applicant is a fit person of fact to sell & know it is suitable & convenient and the applicant having executed a bond as required by law with good security payable to the Commissioners of Vermont, in a penalty of Five hundred dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance
