for his examination and payment.

The Court Certified that William Wrenhart, Wm H. Drury, Samuel Pugh and Charles
Muirphy, Esq. T. Drury, G. C. Tanguant, Geo. W. Lawrence, Edwin Williams, Charles
Stephens, and entitled to One dollar each, for their Service at this time,
grandjuring, to be paid out of the County Tax.

Copy transmitted this day, came G. W. Drury, who alleged that he is approved by an examination
to practice medicine & license tax made by John J. Dyer Commissioner of the
Revenue for District No. 3. in Said County in the year 1878. Whereby he is
charged with \$15. license tax from the 1st day of April 1878 to the 30th
April 1879 to practice Medicine. That he did not practice Medicine at
any time during said period & made no application for said license
and therefore the said G. W. Drury moved the Court to remit him
from the payment of \$15. all of said tax so erroneously charged against him
for said year which when was defended by J. B. Poore, the attorney for
the Commissioners for said County and the said John J. Dyer, the Commissioner
who made the assessment, was examined as a witness touching the
application and it appearing to the Court that the said G. W. Drury did
erroneously appear with a license tax, and that application for remitting
said erroneous tax was made on this day for the first time, and it
appearing that the said G. W. Drury did not practice Medicine at any time
during the period from the 1st day of May 1878, to the 30th day of
April 1879, of which the Court Certified as facts proved upon the
application aforesaid, On Consideration Whereof and from such facts as
proved the Court is satisfied that the said G. W. Drury is erroneously
charged with tax amounting to \$15. Whereupon it is Ordered that
the said G. W. Drury be remitted from the payment of \$15. tax so
erroneously charged, if not already paid, and if paid, that it be refunded
to him. And it is Ordered that the said John J. Dyer, pay the cost
of this application.

On the Motion of J. M. Gay, & for reasons appearing to the Court to be
exempted from working the Road in future, his being disabled ad interim.
