X Copy transcribed This day Came L. W. Jones, who alleges that he is aggrieved by an erroneous appearance of a license tax made by John J. Dyer, Commissioner of the Revenue for District No. 3, in said County in the year 1875. Whereby he is charged with \$15. license tax from the 1st day of May 1875 to the 30th April 1877 to practice Medicine. That he did not practice Medicine at any time during said period & made an application for said license and thereupon the said L. W. Jones moved the Court to cancel him from the payment of \$15. all of said tax to erroneously charged against him for said year, which motion was defended by J. B. Pious, the attorney for the Commissioner for said County, and the said John J. Dyer, the Commissioner, who made the appearance, was examined as a witness touching the application. And it appearing to the Court that the said L. W. Jones did erroneously appear with a license tax, and that application for redress against the erroneous entry was made on this day for the first time, and it appearing that the said L. W. Jones did not practice Medicine at any time during the period from the 1st day of May 1875, to the 30th day of April 1877, All which the Court Certified as facts proved upon the application aforesaid, On Consideration Whereof and from such facts it proved the Court is satisfied that the said L. W. Jones is erroneously charged with license tax amounting to \$15. Whereupon it is Ordered that the said L. W. Jones be exonerated from the payment of \$15. how he erroneously charged, if not already paid, and if paid, that it be refunded to him. And it is Ordered that the said John J. Dyer, pay the cost of this application.

On the Motion of J. M. Fay, & for reasons appearing to the Court he is exempted from working the Road in future, he being disabled and infirm.
