

Deed of Trust, dated 17th July 1879 from Wm. C. Beale to Jno. A. Ponce trustee for the benefit of Wm. C. Beale's heirs, conveying present crops was admitted to record July 17th 1879.

A Certificate of the qualification of Kellogg Carson as Constable in Byrd's Magistrate District, was this day returned and ordered to be recorded, and is in the following words, to wit, "State of Virginia, Southampton County to wit, I Joseph H. Venable Judge of the County Court of the County on State aforesaid, do hereby certify that Kellogg Carson who was at the General Election held on the fourth Thursday in May 1879, elected Constable in the Byrd's Magistrate District in the County aforesaid by the qualified voters of the said District did on the 25 day of June 1879, in the presence of the County Court aforesaid, appear before me & qualify by entering into bond and taking the Oath of Office, which is certified to the Clerk of the County Court."

Boyer's Guardianship of Thomas J. John W. and Annie L. (Burkhead), & Joseph B. Rimes Guardianship of Susanna A. Rimes & and James W. Gray & Wm. F. Sebrill's Guardianship of John & Margaret C. Whitehead and its account of Lorrain A. Beale's Guardianship of Parkley & Beale, having been one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office, and no exception being filed thereto, they were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The Court do not appoint Mollie A. Story Guardian of Edwin F. Mottet B. & Wm. F. Story Orphans of Edwin R. Story decd. and thereupon the said Mollie A. Story, together with Joseph L. Williams her Security, (who justified on Oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars, conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded.
