

The Court doth appoint B. H. Nicholson & Justice of the Peace in the former Magistrate District of Thomas Vanyland, in the Bygones Magistrate District, this County, to fill the Vacancies existing in said Office by the reason of the failure of said Nicholson & Vanyland to qualify themselves to hold the same provided by law. And therefore the said Nicholson & Vanyland qualify themselves by taking the Oath required by law.

The Court doth appoint Geo. H. Magel Constable in the Ironwood Mill, Magistrate District in this County, to fill the Vacancy existing in said Office by reason of the failure of said Magel to qualify himself to hold the same provided by law. Thereupon the said Geo. H. Magel, together with Jas. C. Seibell, Geo. S. Jones, James R. Ketter, A. B. Kinsard & Th. P. Pope, his Secretary, (who justified as Constables as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Magel also took the Oath required by law.

On the Motion of W. F. Bradshaw, who made Oath according to law and together with W. W. Bragg his Security, who justified as Constable as to his Sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of Ten Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration of the Estate of James Barnes dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that R. M. Stephenson, R. A. Irony, E. F. Irony, & M. S. Butler (or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose) do appraise all the goods & Chattels of James Barnes dec'd. & return the appraisement into their hands as the law directs.

Jas. C. Seibell, J. G. Little & W. A. Seibell the Commissioners appointed to the last term of this Court to select the repairs of Camp's Bridge, this day made their report accompanied by Specifications and Bonds from the Undertaker, which is ratified and Confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed. And it is Ordered that the said Commissioners return to said work when completed according to Contract and make report to Court.

Wm. Vanyland & Jas. C. Seibell two of the Commissioners appointed to select & receive the rebuilding of the Farmer's Bridge at the May Term last of this Court, this day made their Report receiving the same, which is ratified and Confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

Gen. W. Cott of Seymour Vanyland two of the Commissioners appointed to the February Term last of this Court to let to the lowest Undertaker the repairs of the bridge known as the goat Bridge, this day made their Report receiving the same, which is ratified and Confirmed by the Court and ordered to be filed.

Ordered that the account of H. D. White Constable amounting to Three White dollars & the account of J. B. Barnes, also for the same amount in the same Prince, amounting to Three dollars, be Certified to the Auditor of the Court.
