

The Court doth appoint C. H. Nicholson & Swain of the Town in the Magisterial District of Thimble Vaughan, in the Hopkins Magisterial District, in this County, to fill the Vacancies existing in Said Office by the reason of the failure of said Nicholson & Vaughan to qualify, whereof witness the sum of £1000 of and thereupon the said Nicholson & Vaughan qualified by taking the Oath required by law.

The Court doth appoint Gen. St. Mayet Constable in the Druryville Magisterial District in this County, to fill the Vacancy existing in Said Office by reason of the failure of said Mayet to qualify, whereof witness the sum of £1000 of and thereupon the said Gen.
