Ordered that the account of Bernard Moore amounting to Twelve ²/₁₀₀ dollars be certified to the Board of Supervisors of this County.

Ordered that J. de Burden and Dr. L. Lantford & B. Brown on the part of this County, with Commissioners acting on the part of Isle of Wight County examined & let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Jagers Bridge across Black Water River, that they receive the same when completed according to contract & make report to Court. And it is ordered that a Copy of this Order be Certified to the Clerk of Isle of Wight County.

Ordered that Wm. Pinnis, John Williams & Joseph D. Smith be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across Wm. Pinnis Mill Swamp, and report to Court.

Ordered that James Vanhook, Wm. H. Peterson & Geo. W. Cuth be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across the Cypress Swamp near the residence of the late Elisha Fardine, & report to Court.

Ordered that the Clerk of this Court deliver to J. B. Ege of Petersburg Va. to be bound as required by an act of the General Assembly of Va. approved Feb'y 15th 1879, all the Books showing the apprehend of Land in this County since the year 1850. But such Books shall not be delivered to the said Ege, unless he shall have entered into bond with approved Security, payable to the County of Southampton for the sum of One Thousand dollars, Conditioned for the safe return of said Books to this Office and to secure them from mutilation.

On the application of M. W. Butler, who desires to distribute and sell religious Books, Tracts &c. and the Court being satisfied that he is a person of good Character & a proper person to whom to confide the trust of selling or distributing said Books, doth direct the Commissioners of the Revenue to grant him license with a Renewal two only under Section 32nd Chapter 34th Code of Virginia 1873.

Wm. H. Parker who has been duly licensed to practice the law in the Court of this Commonwealth, in his motion has leave to practice in this Court, and thereupon he took the Oath required by law.

John J. Eger Commissioner of the Revenue for the 2nd District in this County with the consent of the Court doth appoint John S. Seibert his assistant and thereupon the said John S. Seibert, qualified by taking the Oath of Office required by law.

On the motion of James M. Butler and for reasons appearing to the Court he is exempted from the payment of taxes & fees in future, the Court aged and informed.
