to be taken away from the place of delivery, but to be drunk at the place
where sold. Wine, Ardent Spirits, Malt Liquors, Cider or any mixture thereof,
at his house at Kinnard's Depot, in this County, for the period beginning
on the 18th day of August 1879 & expiring on the 30th day of April 1880,
the Court being fully satisfied that the applicants are fit persons & that
their place of business is suitable and convenient, and that the applicants
having executed a bond as required by law, with good security, payable to
the Government of Virginia, in a penalty of Five hundred dollars,
Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the
