The Report of the Commissioners approved to let and remove the Flat Swamp Bridge near Abram, the Farmer's Bridge across the approaches of the Flat Bridge & the Commissioners approved to purchase a rope of Boat for Mowens ferry, having been certified to the Board of Supervisors, & they having determined by a recorded vote of their Board of Supervisors, that the said expending and proper, (which action has been duly certified to this Court,) It is Ordered that the said Reports be filed.

Walter Vick, Surveyor of the Road from Old Vicksburg to the Luther Church in Barton & Son Magisterial District, this day rendered his report, which the Court accepts.

The Court doth appoint J. W. Johnson, Surveyor of the Road from Old Vicksburg to the Luther Church, in Barton & Son Magisterial District, in the place of Walter Vick, this day resigned.

James Hale is appointed Surveyor of the Road from the Sign post near Peter's Church by Appaheville Mills & Fortville to the Upper County Court and from J. H. Appaheville to the Upper County Court on the Eastern Side Road, being present at 75 in Tidewater Magisterial District. John T. Harris, removed from the County.
