Ordered That the following accounts be set. One in favor of J. B. Rame

& Jm. A. Low One in favor of Jas. E. Selma Treasurer of this County amounting to
seven to the United dollars and One in favor of Jm. A. Lawrence, Constable, amount
a Bragg for Thirty two 19/100 dollars, be Certified to the Auditor of Public
Accounts for his examination & payment.

Gen. Moore, Surveyor of the Road, tenders his resignation which the Court accepts
and doth appoint J. W. Williams in his stead.

J. B. Jagers, Surveyor of the Road tenders his resignation which the Court accepts and
doth appoint J. L. Kellster in his stead.

J. W. Harris, Surveyor of the Road, tenders his resignation which the Court
accepts & doth appoint Charles M. Jagers in his stead.

The Court doth appoint Richd. E. Vanglen, Surveyor of the Road in the
place of Godwin Parker, who has removed the County.

Justice R. Edwards Surveyor of the Road tenders his resignation which the
Court accepts & doth appoint W. C. Beaman in his stead.

N. B. Ridley Surveyor of the Road tenders his resignation which the
Court accepts.

On the Motion of Jm. Mmond, Will Turner & Orlan Kifer, and for
reasons appearing to the Court they are exempted from the payment
of taxes & levies in future, they being aged and infirm.

The last Will & Testament of Charlotte Leigh died was proved ^{according}
to the Order of Geo. W. Turner and J. D. Munroe, the two Subscribing
Witnesses thereto, and Ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of
G. W. Munroe the Executor therein named, who made Oath accord
ding to law, and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the
penalty of Five Thousand Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs,
(but without Security the Court directing that how should be required,
and the Court requiring none.) Which bond is Ordered to be
recorded. Certificate is granted the said G. W. Munroe, for
obtaining a perbat of the said Will in due form.

An Inquisition taken before M. D. Putney a Justice of the Peace, and acting
Coroner, on the body of Milton Rayford, was returned and Ordered to be
filed.
