

At the 1st day of June, Darden Commissioner of the Roads for District No 1 of Lee County this day made his Report in accordance with the 8th Section of Chapter 153 of the acts of the General Assembly of Va 1866 & 17 approved March 30 1867 Which report is Ordered to be filed.

Darden took the following accounts to care, One in favor of J. B. Price City for the Communiement in the Court amounting to Fifteen dollars, & Jim A. Low One in favor of Jas E. Selby Treasurer of Lee County amounting to sum to be Paided dollars and One in favor of Gen. W. L. Lawrence, Commissary amount W. Briggs owing to Thirty two 1/200 dollars, to Certify to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination of payment.

✓ Gen. Moore, Surveyor of the Roads, tendered his resignation which the Court accepts and don't appoint G. W. Williams in his stead.

✓ J. B. Jones, Surveyor of the Roads tendered his resignation which the Court accept and don't appoint J. L. Bellotter in his stead.

✓ C. W. Harris, Surveyor of the Roads tendered his resignation which the Court accept and don't appoint Charles M. Jones in his stead.

✓ The Court don't appoint Richd T. Vaughan, Surveyor of the Roads in the place of Godwin Parker, who has removed the County.

✓ Luther R. Edwards Surveyor of the Roads tendered his resignation which the Court accept and don't appoint W. E. Baumer in his stead.

✓ N. B. Ridley Surveyor of the Roads tendered his resignation which the Court accept.

✓ On the motion of Dan Moss, Will Turner & Ogleton H. Jr., and for reasons appearing to the Court they are exempted from the payment of taxes & rates in future, they being aged and infirm.

✓ The last Will & Testament of Charlotte Leigh did also formerly to the Posts of Geo. W. Turner and J. D. Marquard, the two Subscribing Witnesses thereto, and Ordered to be recorded. And as the Will of G. N. Musgrave the Executor therein named, who made Posts according to law, and entered into and acknowledged the same in the presence of Five Thousand Dollars, conditioned as the law directs, but without Security the will directing that none should be required, and the Court requiring none) Which bond is Ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said J. D. Marquard, for obtaining a Probat of the said Will in due form.

✓ An Application taken before M. S. Butler a Justice of the Peace, and acting Commissioner for the City of Milton Rayford, was returned and Ordered to be filed.
