

Mrs. Edwards's ^{to} Mr. Joseph D. Howard, Jailor of this County, amounting to \$1000 delivered to him \$500 dollars, One in favor of Delany Green Constable, amounting to the sum of \$500 dollars, One in favor of Samuel W. Davis, Constable, delivered amounting to \$1000 dollars, he severally Certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examinations & payments.

Ordered that the account of Mr. Joseph D. Howard Jailor of this County, amounting to \$1000 dollars for the maintenance & care of Delany Green, Constable, in the Jail of this County, & being paid to the Clerk of the Court immediately after the Commencement of the said Prisoners, & at least One in every ten months thereafter, application was made to the Board of Directors of this County for admission, & that such application was refused for want of room.

The last Will & Testament of Benjamin W. Pierce did. was proved by the Oath of Wm. H. White & R. H. Rollins, the two subscribing Witnesses thereto, and Ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of J. E. L. Holmes, who made Oath according to law of his right wife to R. H. Rollins & James E. Bellotti his Security, (who justified in Oath as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Three Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said J. E. L. Holmes for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of James Holmes did. in due form.

Ordered that Mr. Sanford, Jr. L. Sanford, J. W. North, Robert Harris & James E. Bellotti, (or any three of them,) being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of James Holmes did. and return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

The Court doth appoint Charles W. Nicholson Guardian of William, Frederick Jr., George, Cox, George, Kate, Frederick and Walter Parker Children of W. J. Parker, and thereupon the said Charles W. Nicholson together with the said Bond his Security, (who justified in Oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

The Court doth appoint Jordan Williford Guardian of Virginia D. Smith, Infant of John D. Smith did. & thereupon the said Jordan Williford together with W. W. Briggs his Security, (who justified in Oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One dollar, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of Mrs. Edwards, who made Oath according to law of her right husband to R. H. Rollins & James E. Bellotti his Security, (who justified in Oath as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Three Hundred Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

It appearing to the Court that the said Mrs. Edwards is the wife of the said James E. Bellotti, and that she is the mother of the said James E. Bellotti, the Court doth order that the said bond be returned to the said Mrs. Edwards.

Ordered that the said Mrs. Edwards be appointed Guardian of the said James E. Bellotti.

It appearing to the Court that the said Mrs. Edwards is the wife of the said James E. Bellotti, and that she is the mother of the said James E. Bellotti, the Court doth order that the said bond be returned to the said Mrs. Edwards.

Ordered that the said Mrs. Edwards be appointed Guardian of the said James E. Bellotti.

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
