

On the Motion of Martha Barney, One of the heirs at law of James Barney dec'd. It is Ordered that <sup>Wm</sup> Henry Bond, of S. Connec, & E. T. Irving, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, of going to Sarah Barney Widow of said James Barney, One third in Value of all the real Estate, Wherof ~~she~~ said husband dec'd died seized, as her share in said Estate, & Make report to Court.

It appearing to the Satisfaction of the Court that B. C. Pope, Guardian of George M. Pope has expended the sum of \$800 in excess of the income of his ward's Estate since he qualified as Guardian, of that such expensitures had been prudent & reasonable, the Court doth Order that the same be confirmed.

Ordered that J. I. Smith, John Williams & J. J. Egan, be appointed Commissioners to look to the house, undertake the repairs of Undertakers, Bridge across Tipler Swamp at Triners Mill & Make report to Court.

As Mr. Bond having left the County, the Court doth appoint Sol. Stuyvesant, Surveyor of the Road from the Sign Post near S. H. Davis to Long run, thence to Jones Bridge, in his stead.

Charles S. Stephenson Surveyor of the Road from Kettles Mill Pond to the Coltham Road this day tendered his resignation, which the Court accepts & doth appoint <sup>Wm</sup> H. Lane in his stead.

Ordered that R. W. Burges, John Holmes, & John Bayant, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do examine the same for a new Road to run from Sand Spring on the public Road running through the name of W. H. Urquhart to the Jerusalem and Ancientfield Road near the road at Duckers Swamp & report to the Court the Convenience & inconvenience that will result to individuals as well as to the public, if such Road be opened as proposed, and especially whether any roads, Orchards, Gardens, or any part thereof, will on such Road have to be taken?

Ordered that J. H. Gordon, J. H. Prince & G. H. Hughes, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise and set the value of the goods & chattels of William Vandy and return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

J. H. Prince, Surveyor of the Road from the Green Hill to Dshawe Blaine this day tendered his resignation, which the Court accepts, and doth appoint John E. Pierce in his stead.

Ordered that an Oecumen of the Poor of this County be appointed to Edgum Whitehead (Colon?) the following names: Maria Childers, the Childers of Vinny Ferguson, to wit, Cordey Ferguson, aged Eleven years; Colyale Ferguson, aged nine years;
