

On the Motion of Marshall Barnes, One of the heirs at law of James Barnes dec'd. It is Ordered that Wm. H. Bond, of S. Connec, & Edw. Irving, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, of going to Sarah Barnes Widow of said James Barnes, One third in value of all the real Estate, Whose said said husband dec'd says, as his share in said Estate, & make report to Court.

It appearing to the Satisfaction of the Court that B. C. Pope, Guardian of George M. Pope has expended the sum of \$800 in excess of the income of his Ward's Estate since he qualified as Guardian, & that such expenditures have been prudent & reasonable, the Court doth Order that the same be confirmed.

Ordered that J. L. Smith, John Williams & J. H. Egan, be appointed Commissioners to go to the house, undertaking the repairs of Embankment, Bridge across Tipler Swamp at Trinner's Mill & make report to Court.

It Wm. Bond having left the County, the Court doth appoint Silvester Sawyer of the Road from the Sign Post near T. Bonds to Longmeadow, thence to Jones Bridge, in his stead.

Charles S. Stephenson Surveyor of the Road from Kedar's Mill Pond to the Coltham Road this day tendered his resignation, which the Court accepts & doth appoint Wm. H. Bond in his stead.

Ordered that R. W. Burgess, John Holmes, & John Bryant, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do examine the same for a new Road to run from said point on the public Road running through the name of Wm. H. Urquhart to the Jerusalem and Mountfield Road near the road at Tucker Swamp, & report to the Court the convenience & inconvenience that will result to individuals as well as to the public, if such Road be opened as proposed, and especially whether any roads, Orchard, Garden, or any part thereof, will on such Road have to be taken?

Ordered that J. H. Gordon, J. H. Prince & G. H. Hughes, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise and set the goods & chattels of Sterling Vasey dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands as the law directs.

J. H. Prince Surveyor of the Road from the Greenview line to D. Shaw's place this day tendered his resignation, which the Court accepts, and doth appoint John E. Pierce in his stead.

Ordered that an Overseer of the Poor of this County, be as appointing to Edgemoor Whitehead (Colonist) the following named Minor Children, the Children of Vinny Ferguson, to wit, Corbett Ferguson, aged Eleven years; Colgate Ferguson, aged nine years,
