

not Guilty to the Indictment and a panel of sixteen Persons out of the twenty four summoned by the Sheriff were examined by the Court and found free from all legal exceptions and qualified to serve as jurors according to law. Whereupon the accused peremptorily challenged four of the jurors, and the remaining twelve to wit, N. B. Bryant, Geo. W. Whitfield, Wm. Brantley, H. K. Williams, W. J. Cobb, Moses Jayner, O. D. Bell, Edgar W. Davis, Adolphus Gadsdaway, Charles W. Whitehead, William Briggs and Geo. W. Brittle, who being elected, tried and sworn the truth of and upon the premises to speak, and having heard a partly the evidence were, with the consent of the Prisoner, committed to the custody of the Sheriff of this County, who is directed to keep them together, without communication with any other person, and to cause them to appear here to morrow morning at ten O'clock. Whereupon an oath was administered to W. W. Briggs Sheriff and to James H. Harder Deputy Sheriff of this County, to the following effect: "You shall well and truly, to the best of your ability, keep this jury, and neither speak to them yourself, nor suffer any other person to speak to them touching any matter Relative to this trial until they return into Court to-morrow." And the said Dewitt Felts is remanded to jail.
