in all to whom these presents shall come, Knowing, Know you, that
we know, having been duly notified of the Election, by the great
Vote of the true house of the General Assembly, of C. C. Barrett, as
Judge of the County Court of Southampton County, for the Term of Office
provided by law, do hereby Commission him, the said C. C. Barrett, Judge
of the said Court, to exercise the functions and to discharge the duties of
his Office according to law.
