

On the petition of R. J. Bristol Guardian of W. L. Tamm, it is Ordered that said Guardian do attend to expend One hundred dollars of the principal of his said ward's Estate, for his Support and Education for the year 1880.

On the petition of Jacob M. Bryant, Guardian of Laura V. Bryant, it is Ordered that said Guardian do attend to expend One hundred dollars of the principal of his said ward's personal Estate for her Support and Education for the present year, and a portion of next year.

The License heretofore granted to R. B. Cook for the privilege of selling ardent spirits by Retail (in) to keep, at Providence in the town of Franklin, in this County, is transferred to R. M. Davis, to Commence on the 15th day of March 1880.

The License heretofore granted to A. A. Savage for the privilege of selling ardent spirits by Retail at Broad-horn's Mill in this County is transferred to Joseph H. Barnes with the privilege of retelling the same at Berlin in this County, to Commence on the 1st day of March 1880.

If Robert Lewis is this day granted to Joseph H. Barnes on his application to sell by the Drink in quantities of not more than One half pint, not to be taken from the place of delivery, but to be drunk at the place where sold, Wine, Ardent Spirits, Malt Liquors, or any mixture thereof, at his place of business at Berlin in this County, for the period beginning on the 1st day of March 1880, and expiring on the thirtieth day of April 1880, the Court being fully satisfied upon hearing the evidence that the applicant is a fit person, and that the place of business is suitable & convenient, and that the specific tax required of law has been paid to the proper officer, and the applicant having executed a bond as required by law, with good security, payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty of One hundred and fifty dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, entitled, "An act imposing a tax and providing for the Mode of Collecting the Same, on the privilege of selling, Wine, Ardent Spirits, or Malt Liquors, within the limits of the Commonwealth for the Support of the Government and to pay the interest on the Public debt, Approved March 30th 1877, as amended by the Act Approved April 5th 1877, (and) as amended by the Act Approved April 1st 1879.

Ordered that the account of W. H. Baker amounting \$35.00 for defending John Hester &c be certified to the Board of Supervisors for their examination and payment.
