

William N. Sebrall who was on this 21st day of June the year 1880, duly appointed Assessor to assess the value of all lands and lots, together with the taxes thereon in the Second District within said county pursuant to Section 6 of Article 10 of the Constitution and Chapter 32 of the Code of Virginia, 1873, ~~was~~ amended by the Act approved March 1873, entitled an act to amend Sections 13 and 14 and Chapter 32 of the Code 1873, and to repeal Sections 13, 14, 15, and 16 of said Chapter, in relation to a payment of the lands of the County of Loudoun, and Chapter 78, Section 5, and Chapter 78, Section 9, this day appeared in Court together with James E. Sebrall, his deputy, duly qualified as to their sufficiency, and in and acknowledged in open Court, in the Penalty of Five Thousand Dollars, for the faithful performance of the duties of his Office according to Law, which bond is to be recorded by the Clerk of this Court, and is directed to transmit a copy of said bond and copy of this order to the Auditor of Public Accounts. And thereupon the said Hon: N. Sebrall took several oaths required by Law.
