✓ On the Motion of W. R. Brantley of Newton Bridge Colm, & for reasons appearing to the Court they are exempted from the payment of Compensation taxes in full, they being aged and infirm.

✓ Thomas J. Darden is appointed Surveyor of the Road from James Vaughan to Smith Ferry, in the place of Thomas K. Daugherty.

✓ James E. Dugay, Surveyor of the Road between us Pointe Run, this day tendered his resignation which the Court accepts, and that appoint of S. H. Brinkley in his stead.

✓ On the Motion of George E. Boston, who made Oath according to Law, and deposed with William H. Boston his Security, (who justified on Oath as to his Sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted to said George E. Boston for obtaining Letter of administration on the Estate of Captain Harris deceased with his will annexed in due form.

✓ The Court don't appoint Richard H. Rants, Guardian of Fannie Poole, Orphan of Poole, and thereupon the said Richard H. Rants entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Fifty dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

✓ Matthew J. Gaine, Captain of W. H. Laine deceased over fourteen years of age, with the approbation of the Court, made choice of Charles G. Stephenson as his Guardian, and thereupon the said Charles G. Stephenson, together with W. H. Stephenson his security, (who justified on Oath as to his Sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One Thousand Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

✓ The Court don't appoint James E. Selma, Guardian of George M. Piper, Ben E. Piper, Joseph H. Piper, & George C. Piper, Orphans Children of George C. Piper deceased, and thereupon the said James E. Selma, together with Wm. H. Selma, E. D. Russ, Wm. D. Russell, W. W. Brigggs, James R. Kelly, & C. C. Vaughan, his Securities, (who justified on Oath as to their Sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Thirty two thousand dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.
