Thomas G. Darden is appointed Surveyor of the Road from James Vaughan to Smith's Ferry, in the place of Thomas R. Wardyburn.

James E. Phipps, Surveyor of the Road known as Broken Road, this day tenders his resignation which the Court accepts, and does appoint J. M. Brindle in his stead.

On the motion of George E. Beaton, who made Court according to law, and together with William M. Beaton his Security (who justified on Court as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Four hundred dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said George E. Beaton for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Anthony Harris dec'd with his will annexed in due form.

The Court doth appoint Richard H. Rando, Guardian of Fannie Poles Orphan of Poles, and hereupon the said Richard H. Rando entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Fifty dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

Mathew J. Laine, Captain of W. H. Laine dec'd. Over fourteen years of age, with the approbation of the Court, made choice of Charles G. Stephenson as his Guardian, and thereupon the said Charles G. Stephenson, together with W. H. Stephenson his Security, (who justified on Court as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.

The Court doth appoint James C. Seluda, Guardian of George M. Phipps, Ben E. Phipps, Joseph M. Phipps, & George C. Phipps, Orphan Children of George C. Phipps dec'd. and thereupon the said James C. Seluda, together with Wm. A. Seluda, E. D. Reese, Wm. D. Seluda, Wm. P. Phipps, James R. Seluda, & C. C. Vaughan, his Security, (who justified on Court as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Twenty two thousand dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is Ordered to be recorded.
