On motion of A. J. Pretlow, ordered that L. C. Williams, J. D. Pretlow, Jas. W. Lawrence & Junius W. Williams be appointed commissioners (any three of whom may act) to view a route for a new road proposed to commence at the corner for W. B. Shanos & S. Kindred in front of the Baptist Church in Jerusalem and to run in a line, as nearly straight as may be, to a point in the road leading from A. J. Pretlow's yard on the Bayant ~~Turn~~ to Franklin & near said yard to end.

Ordered that the following lands to wit: The lands on the Gurley Place - The lands on L. K. Edwards Place - Nancy Turner place, Jordan Williams's Son's farm. The places on Worrell land now occupied by Rachel Hardy, Harriet Pitts, Jacob Butts. The place belonging to Rochelle Estate occupied by Parker Parker. The place on Worrell land occupied by Dick Jones & Henry Jones be transferred to the road over which Junius W. Williams is Surveyor.

The Court doth allow Wm. M. Beaton, Orris Moore, Leonard C. Cobb, James Vaughan, Hillary Vaughan, Maddison Cobb, A. W. Torpelt, W. C. White, P. W. Fuller, Hewitt Branch, John S. Cobb, Jas. J. Darden, Lucillius Barrett, Wm. E. Morpicket, C. C. Ferguson, John C. Sykes and Wm. E. Worrell, one dollar each for their services at this Term of Grand Jurors, to be paid out of the County's Lm.

The Court certifies that J. B. Lewis, J. W. Pond, Orris Charles, E. W. Davis, E. A. Kelle, J. L. Cobb, W. H. Cobb, L. K. Williams, J. W. Johnson, A. J. Bradshaw, A. N. Railroad and J. J. Sayner are entitled to receive one dollar each, for services at this term as Jurors in the trial of prosecutions for misdemeanors, to be paid out of the Public Treasury.

Dennis Sykes and James Hunt who stand bound by recognizance entered into before this Court at the July Term thereof, to appear here before this Court on the first day of the August Term thereof, were this day solemnly called but came not. Whereupon it is ordered that a Writ of Seize Facias be issued against the said Sykes and Hunt returnable to the first day of the September Term next.
