

Deluge Court, when on the 18th day of October 1860, was at the time of
W. P. Schenk & Joseph L. Spethman, Sec. of his Securing at his Official
Bond as Constable of Bayview Magisterial District, required to execute
a writ with security, then by writ W. H. Beaton, Gen. C. Beaton,
W. W. Briggs & J. H. Johnson, his Securing, (who justified on Oath
as to their sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in
the penalty of Two Hundred dollars, conditioned according to law,
which bond is ordered to be recorded.

A Writ being dated the 27th day of June 1860, for putting in to
the last will & Testament of James Barden, did this day present
to the Court for probate, and it being proved to the Court, that James
the execution of the said will, the said James Barden, the Executor
has intervened, the Court thereof refused to admit the said will
into probate, as and for the last will & Testament, of the said James
Barden, deceased.

J. W. Williams, the Securing of John Blythe, in his bond as Commissioner
of the person & Estate of Adeline Foster & directing to be released there-
from. It is ordered that the said John Blythe do Surrender to appear
here & show Cause, if any he can, why the said J. W. Williams
should not be released from his said Securingship. Whereupon the
said John Blythe appeared in person, & the said Williams & Blythe
being fully heard, it is the Opinion of the Court, & accordingly
Ordered, that the said John Blythe give a good bond in the penalty of
Two hundred dollars, with good Security thereto. Whereupon the said
John Blythe came in Court, with J. de la Porden as his Securing,
(who justified on Oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and
acknowledged a bond, in the penalty of Two hundred dollars,
conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be
recorded.

The Commissioners appointed at the July Term last of this Court, to
make the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Sale of Wright
& find Pontiac's Bridge, New Orleans, under Bond, this day made their
Report, which is ratified & confirmed by the Court & ordered to be
filed. And it is ordered that the said Commissioners to
wit, C. G. Ireland, David C. Drew, & Robert L. Baint, do certify
with G. B. Jack, of C. Holliman & W. O. D. Gooding, Commissioners
appointed by the County Court of Sale of Wright, but to the Court
understanding its repairs of the said Bridge, & make report to
Court.

The Commissioners appointed to receive the Bridge, on the Road
known as the "Angels Bridge" this day made Report, which
is ratified & confirmed by the Court & ordered to be filed.
And it appearing from said Report that the expenses were
incurred thereon dollars, it is ordered that the said Report
be referred to the Board of Supervisors of this County
