Mixture thereof, of Charles River, or District purchased in Ardent Spirit,  
in quantities not exceeding five gallons, at anytime, to any one individual,  
at their several places of business in the County, which shall not  
be drunk within the town or City or other place where sold, but shall be  
delivered to the purchaser in bottle, jug, demijohn, or other vessel,  
to be removed therefrom, for the purpose beginning at the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April  
1880, & expiring on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1881, the Court being fully  
satisfied, upon hearing the evidence, that the applicants are  
fit persons, & that their place of business is suitable and  
convenient, & that the specific sum required to be paid has been paid  
to the proper Officer, & the applicants having executed a  
bond in support of and with good Security, payable to the  
Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty of One hundred dollars,  
conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements  
of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, entitled,  
"An act imposing a tax & prescribing regulations for collecting  
the same, on the privilege of Selling Wine, Ardent Spirit, or Malt
