Meatance there of, Blackholo Butter, & Spirit forwarded in Ardent Spirit,
in quantities not exceeding five gallons, at any time, to any law individual
or their several places of business in the County, which shall not
be drunk within the House or Cartelip where sold, but shall be
delivered to the purchaser in bottle, jugs, demijohns, or other glass,
to be removed thence, for the period beginning at the 15th day after
1880, & expiring on the 30th day of April 1881, the Court being fully
Satisfied, upon hearing of the evidence, that the applicants are
fit persons, & that their place of business is Quaint and
Convenient, & that the specific time required of land has been given
to the proper Officer, & the application having executed a
bill in respect of land with good Security, payable to the
Commonwealth of Virginia, in a penalty of One hundred dollars,
Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements
of the act to the General Assembly of Virginia, intituled,
"An act imposing & enacting and promulgating regulations for collecting
the same, or the privileges of Selling Wine, Ardent Spirit, or Malt
Liquor, or any Meatance there of, within the limits to the Commonwealth,
