

The License heretofore granted to W. J. Roth & Co. to retail and sell
 Spirits & Wine & Beer & Cider is with the Consent of the Court transferred
 to Charles Parker & W. J. Pease.

A Bar Room License is this day granted to Parker & Pease on their
 Application to Sell by the Drunk not to be taken away from the
 place of delivery, but to be drunk at the place where said
 Godwin Spirits, Malt Liquors, or any Mixture thereof, or Ferments
 or Ferments produced in Godwin Spirits, at their place of
 business in the Town of Franklin in this County, for the period
 beginning on the 20th day of December 1880, & expiring on the
 30th day of April 1881, the Court being fully satisfied upon
 hearing the evidence that the applicants are fit persons &
 that their place of business is suitable and convenient and
 that the specific tax required by law has been paid to the
 proper Officer, and the applicants having executed a bond
 as required by law, with good Security, payable to the
 Commonwealth of Virginia in a penalty of One hundred
 Dollars, Conditioned for the faithful performance of all
 the requirements of the act of the General Assembly of
 Virginia, entitled "An act imposing a tax and prescribing
 the regulations for collecting the same on the privilege of selling
 Wine, Godwin Spirits or Malt Liquors, or any Mixture thereof,
 within the limits of the Commonwealth, for the support of the
 Government & to pay the Duties on the Public Debt," approved
 March 3rd 1880.

A License is this day granted to Parker & Pease & J. P. Brown
 their Application to Sell by Retail only in quantities up to five gallons
 at any one time, to any one individual, Wine, Godwin Spirits, Malt Liquors
 or any Mixture thereof, or Ferments produced in Godwin
 Spirits in quantities not exceeding five gallons at any time to any one
 individual at their place of business in this County, which place not
 be drunk within the limits of the Commonwealth, but to be taken
 away to the purchaser in bottles, jars, demijohns, or other vessels, to be
 removed therefrom for the period beginning on the 20th day of December
 1880, & expiring on the 30th day of April 1881, the Court being fully
 satisfied upon hearing the evidence that the applicants are
 fit persons & that their place of business is suitable and convenient
 and that the specific tax required by law has been paid to the proper
 Officer, & the applicants having executed a bond as required
 by law, with good Security, payable to the Commonwealth of
 Virginia, in a penalty of One hundred Dollars, Conditioned for
 the faithful performance of all the requirements of the act of the
