

On the Motion of Penelope Bradstreet Widow of James Bradstreet deceased it is Ordered that T. deBordeaux, M. G. L. & others who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose, shall after having given reasonable notice to all the parties interested proceed to and view the premises of her husband James Bradstreet deceased and report thereon to the Court in order to a further decree.

And the Court having this day filed her petition asking the appointment of Commissioners to assist in the settlement of her husband's estate and the Court doth adjudge and order that T. deBordeaux, M. G.
