 and Wine, a Bond there is transferred to James H. Gudkins, the Court being
 fully Satisfied upon hearing the evidence that the applicant is a fit
 person, & that his place of business is suitable and convenient, & that
 upon the said Gudkins executed bond as required by law, payable to the
 Commonwealth of Virginia, with good Security, in the penalty of Two
 hundred dollars, Conditioned for the faithful performance of all
 the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia,
 entitled, "An act imposing a tax & prescribing regulations for
 Collecting the same on the privilege of Selling Wine, Ardent Spirits &c"
 within the limits of the County mentioned," approved March 3^d 1880.

A License is this day granted to C. H. Pope, & J. F. Davis,
 on their application to Sell by Retail only in quantities up to five
 gallons at any one time, to any One individual, Wine, Ardent Spirits, &c
 Liqueurs, or any Mixture thereof, Alcohol or Rectified Spirit, or
 in Ardent Spirits, in quantities not exceeding five gallons, at any time
 to any one individual, at their places of business in this County, which
 shall not be drunk within the limits of Counties upon which said, but shall
 be delivered to the purchaser in bottles, jugs, demijohns, or other
 vessels, to be removed therefrom for the purpose of consuming, the said
 Pope on the 1st day of December 1880, & the said Davis on the
 25th day of February 1881, & imposing on the 30th day of April
 1881, the Court being fully Satisfied that the applicants are fit
 persons and that their places of business are suitable and convenient,
 and that the Specific tax required by law has been paid
 to the proper Officer, & the applicants having executed a bond
 as required by law, with good Security, payable to the Common-
 wealth of Virginia, in a penalty of One hundred dollars,
 Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements
 of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, entitled, "An
 act imposing a tax & prescribing regulations for Collecting the
