A Bond Return License is then duly granted to J. P. Davis, on his application to Sell by the Drunk, not to be taken away from the place of Sale, but to be drunk at the place where Sold, Wine, Ardent Spirits, Malt Liquors, or any Mixture thereof, Alcoholic Beverages, or Drinks purchased in Ardent Spirits at his place of business in this County for the period beginning on the 1st day of February 1881, and expiring on the 30th day of April 1881, the Court being fully satisfied upon viewing the evidence, that the applicant is a fit person, and that the place of business is suitable and convenient and that the Specific Fee required by law has been paid to the proper Officer, and the applicant having executed a bond as required by law, with good Security, payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the penalty of One hundred dollars, Conditioned for the faithful performance of all the requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia entitled, "An act imposing a tax and prescribing regulations for Collection of the same, on the privilege of Selling Wine, Ardent Spirits, or Malt Liquors, or any Mixture thereof, within the limits of the Commonwealth, for the Support of the Government, and to pay the Interest on the Public Debt," approved March 3^d. 1880.
