Considerations but more especially for the good Will and Affection^l
bear to Jesse Whitehead my grandson in the same County and in
Virginia me hereunto moving have Given granted and by these Presents
do give grant and confirm unto the said Jesse Whitehead two Parcels
of Land both in Southampton and on the South side of Mattoway River
bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a Cypress on the West
side of Arthurs Swamp thence West one hundred and ninety five
Poles to a White Oak thence South five Degrees East one hundred
and five Pole to a Pine the South forty Degrees East one hundred
and fifty eight Pole to a Red Oak then East two hundred and six
Poles to a live Oak by the side of Arthurs Swamp aforesaid and
up the various Courses of the Run of the said Swamp to the beginning
