Southampton Planter of the one part and Howell Edmonds of the
County aforesaid Planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Joshua Cope and Sarah his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of
Ten pounds Current Money of this Colony to them in Hand well and
truly paid before the enacting and delivery hereof by the said Howell
Edmonds the Receipt whereof they hereby acknowledge and themselves
thereunto fully Contented satisfied and paid Make given granted
Bargained Sold Alienated Released Conveyed and Confirmed
And by these Presents doth for themselves their Heirs Executors
and Administrators fully freely and absolutely give grant bargain
Sell alienate Release Convey and fully confirm unto the said
Howell Edmonds his Heirs Executors Admins. of Assigns forever
one certain Parcel or Tract of Land situate lying and being in the
County of Southampton and on the South side of Potomack River
Beginning at a Pine on the West side of the Whitewood Swamp
aborn tree formerly by William Cockings now Howell Edmonds
