Edmonds & Long This Indenture made this first Day of July In the Year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and forty nine Between Howell Edmonds and Mary Edmonds his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Arthur Long of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Howell Edmonds and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred of thirty five pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in Hand paid at or before the enrolling and Delivery of these Presents the receipt of which said themselves fully satisfied Contented and paid they doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained and Sold Aliened and confirmed and by these Presents Doth give Grant Bargain and Sell Aliene and confirm unto the said Arthur Long his Heirs and Assigns forever three certain Tracts or Parcels of Lands situate lying and being in the County of Southampton the first Tract or parcell bounded as followeth, to wit, Beginning at a gum on the North side of the Flatt Swamp thence North ten Degrees West fifty Pole to a Red Oak a corner Tree of James Turners then by the said Turners Line North fifteen Degrees last fifty seven Pole to a White Oak then South eighty Degrees last fifty Pole to a White Oak then South forty Degrees East eighty four Pole to a Gum by the side of a small Branch then down the various Courses of the said Branch to the Flatt Swamp aforesaid and up the various Courses of the Run of the said Swamp to the Beginning Containing one hundred Acres be the same more or less The second Tract or parcell Beginning at the mouth of the Wolfpit Branch on the North side of Tarnanoe Creek thence up the various Courses of the Run of the said Branch North thirty seven Degrees West two hundred and thirteen Pole to a marked Pinon
