This Indenture made the eighthth Day of July in the twenty third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second, by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c And in the Year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and forty nine Between Robert Gray Gent of the County of Surry of the one-Part and Joseph Gray of the County of Southampton of the other part Witneseth that the said Robert Gray for and in Consideration of the Sum of one hundred and seventeen pounds ten Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Gray at or before the sealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt-whereof the said Robert Gray doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened entailed released & confirmed and by these Presents doth grant bargain and sell alien entailed release and Confirm unto the said Joseph Gray his Heirs and Assigns forever One certain dividend Tract or Parcel of Land situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton and on the South Side of Nottoway River sit being the same Land the said Robert Gray bought of the Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian^{nation} as appeareth by Deed of Troffment recorded in the County Court of Isle of Wight bearing Date the twenty eighth Day of March in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and forty five / Containing by Estimation three hundred and thirty eight Acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a pine by the side of the Brury Branch Men North sixty Degrees West one hundred and fifty four
