

And Admon one certain tract or parcel of Land containing three
 Hundred Acres more or less situate lying & being on the South Side
 the three Creeks in the County of Southampton aforesaid which said
 tract or parcels of Land being granted to the said Henry Moss by patent
 bearing date this tenth Day of February one Thousand Seven-
 Hundred & forty Eight in the twenty second year of our Soverign the
 said three Hundred Acres being bounded one Moity containing one
 hundred & fifty Acres on the South side of Georges branch & the other
 Moity on the North side of the said branch beginning at a pine
 on the said branch then running along a line of marked trees to
 the head of a little Branch then along the said branch thence to
 a live oak on the side of the said branch thence along a line
 of marked trees to a pine on the side of the fork branch and
 all the Land on the East side of the aforesaid line to conclude
 the abovesaid complement of Three Hundred Acres more or less
 To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with
 the appurtenances unto the said William Johnson his Exors
 Adors from the Day next before the Date of the said recited
 Indenture unto the end & term of one year from thence next
 Ensuing to the Intent that by virtue thereof & of the Statute for
 transferring uses into possession the said William Johnson might
 be in actual possession of the said Land & premises & be
 Enabled to take & Accept of a grant & Release of the reversion
 & Inheritance thereof to him & his Heirs to the use of him
 and his Heirs & assigns forever as by the said recited Indenture
 may more at large appeareth now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said Henry Moss for & in Consideration of the Sum of forty
 pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the
 said William Johnson whereof he doth hereby acknowledge the
 Receipt hath granted remised released & Confirmed & doth by
 these Presents grant remise & Release & Confirm unto the
 said William Johnson in his Actual possession now being by
