This Indenture made the ninth Day of November in the Year

William Lee Sen. & Rebecca his wife of the County of South
-ampton of the one part & John Myrick of the County aforesaid
of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Lee & Rebecca
his wife for & in Consideration of the Sum of Seventy Pounds Ten
Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in Hand paid by
the said John Myrick at & before the sealing & Delivery of these
presents the Receipt whereof the said William Lee & Rebecca
his Wife doth hereby acknowledge Hath Granted, Bargained
& sold, & doth by these presents Grant Bargain & Sell unto the
said John Myrick his Heirs & Assigns forever a certain Tract
or Parcel of Land lying & being in Southampton County aforesaid
& on the South side of the Three Creeks containing by Estimation
one Hundred & ninety Acres to the same more or Less & bounded
as follows, to wit. Beginning at a Red Oak at Corner of the said
Lees other Land thence by his old line South Eighty five Degrees
East fifty Pole to a Hickory, then North fifty Degrees East two
Hundred & fifty two Pole to a Lightwood Post in a line of John
Jubys Land then by Jubys Line West one Hundred & Twenty
Pole to a Pine then South west by South one Hundred & two
Pole to a Red oak then South five Degrees East one Hundred &
Thirty Six Pole to a Black oak Sapling at line trees of Hugh Lees
Land & then by Hugh Lees line East South East Fifty two to
the Beginning & the Reversion & Reversions Remainder and
Remainders Rents Issues & Profits thereof & also all the Estate
Right Title Interest Claim & Demand whatsoever of him the
said William Lee & Rebecca his Wife & their Heirs of in
or to the same or any part thereof To have and to hold
the said Land & premises with all & singular the appurtenances
