William Lee Senr. & Nebeah his wife of the County of South
ampton of the one part. & John Myrick of the County aforesaid
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William Lee & Nebeah
his wife for & in Consideration of the Sum of Seventy Pounds Ten
Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in Hand paid by
the said John Myrick at & before the sealing & Delivery of these
presents the Receipt whereof the said William Lee & Nebeah
his wife doth hereby acknowledge It hath Granted. Bargained
& Sold. & doth by these presents Grant Bargain & Sell unto the
said John Myrick his Heirs & Assigns forever a certain Tract
or Parcel of Land lying & being in Southampton County aforesaid
& on the South side of the three Creeks containing by Estimation
one hundred & Ninety acres both the same more or less & bounded
as follows. to wit. Beginning at a Red Oak at Corners of the said
Land & thence by his old line South Eighty five Degrees
East fifty Pole to a Hickory then North fifty Degrees East two
Hundred & fifty two Poles to a Lightwood Post in a line of John
Jabys Land then by Jaby's Line West one hundred & Twenty
Poles to a Pine then South west by South one hundred & two
Poles to a Red oak then South five Degrees East one hundred &
Thirty Six Poles to a Black oak Sapling at line tree of Hugh Lee
Land & then by Hugh Lee line East South East Fifty two to
the Beginning of the Reversion & Reversions Remainder and
Remainders Rents Issues & Profits thereof & also all the Estate's
Right Title Interest Claim & Demand whatsoever of him the
said William Lee & Nebeah his wife & their Heirs or in
or to the same or any Part thereof To have and to hold
the said Land & premises with all singular the appurtenances
