This Indenture made the tenth Day of October in the Year of
our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and forty nine Between
Thos. Barron Senr & Elizabeth his Wife of the County of Southampton
of the one part and Richard Taylor Senr of the County aforesd
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Barron & Elizabeth his Wife for
and in Consideration of the Sum of seventeen pounds Curr^t Money
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the s^d Richard Taylor before the
sealing & Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the said Thomas
Barron & Elizabeth his Wife doth hereby acknowledge Hath
Granted Bargained & Sold and Doth by these presents Grant
Bargain and Sell unto the said Richard Taylor his Heirs
and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying
and being in Southampton County aforesd and on the North side
Neheamin River containing by estimation one hundred and
Twenty Acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth
viz^t Beginning at a pine a Corner Richard Taylor's Land by
the Side of Cockses Swamp thence by the said Taylor's line
North seventy nine Degrees West Forty poles to a pine and
North west by West Eighty eight Poles to a Hickory thence
North Twenty six Degrees West Twenty four poles to a w^t oak
a Corner of Joshua Cloyd's Land thence by the said Cloyd's line
North Twenty Degrees East one hundred and twenty six poles
to a Red oak & North five Degrees West Eighty six poles to a
pine then South sixty Degrees East sixty poles to a pine
in Thomas Wienn's line thence by the said Wienn's line
South fifteen Degrees West fifty six poles to a red oak South
East by South Ninety seven poles to a Red oak and South
seventy Degrees East seven poles to a live oak by the side
of a small Branch then Down the Courses of the said Branch
to Cockses Swamp aforesaid thence up the various Courses
of the run of the said Swamp to the beginning and the
