This Indenture Tripartite made the first Day of Jan^y
in the twenty third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign
Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain
France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c and in the
Year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred & forty nine
Between Frank, Dochter Tom, Sam, John Turner, Geo. Shipper,
Charles, Watt, & Jack Wile, Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian
Nation of the first part, Joseph Gray, & Thomas Savell of the
County of Southampton Gent. Surviving Trustees of & for
the said Nation of the second Part, and Peter Butts Gent
of the said County of the third part; Whereas by an Act
of Assembly made in the eighteenth Year of his present
Majesty intitled an Act to enable the Nottoway Indians
to sell certain Lands & for other purposes therein mentioned
the Chief Men of the said Nottoway Nation were empowered
