they doth hereby acknowledge and themselves therewith
fully contented satisfied and paid Hask given granted
bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed released conveyed and
confirmed and by these presents doth for themselves
their Heirs Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs} fully freely and absolutely
give grant bargain sell alien Enfeoff release convey and
fully confirm unto the said Howell Edmunds his Heirs Ex^{rs}
Adm^{rs} & Assigns forever one certain Parcel or Tract of Land
situate lying & being in the County of Southampton and
on the Southside of Notoway River Beginning at a Poplar
a Corner tree of the aforesaid Edmunds Land standing in a
small Branch thence ^{South} along a line of markt trees to a red
Oak a Corner tree thence West to the whitewood Swamp
thence up the various Courses of the Run of the said Stream
to the mouth of the small branch aforesaid thence up the
said branch to the beginning containing fifty acres be
