the one part & William Rose of the County aforesaid of the other
part Witnesseth That the said Edmund Pate & Mary his Wife
for & in consideration of the Sum of twenty Pounds Current
Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Rose
before the sealing & Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the said
Edmund Pate & Mary his Wife doth hereby Acknowledge & hath
granted Bargained & sold & Doth by these presents Grant
bargain & sell unto the said William Rose his Heirs and
Assigns forever a certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and
being in Southampton County aforesaid & on the North
Side the Three Creeks Containing by Estimation two
hundred Acres & bounded as followeth / Viz / Beginning
at a red Oak Saplin in John Bitmans line thence North
North East thirty eight Poles to a Lightwood Post in Owen
Myracks line thence by the said Myracks line North
thirty Degrees West nineteen Poles to a pine & North ten
Degrees West one hundred & fifty six Poles to a pine a corner
