 Acknowledge unto the said Absalom Smith thereof giving
 part thereof doth Acquit Exonerate and Discharge by these
 presents hath granted Bargained sold enfeoffed Released and
 confirmed and in and by these presents doth fully and
 Absolutely Grant Bargain Sell enfeoff Release & confirm
 unto the said Absalom Smith his Heirs & Assigns forever
 one certain Tract of Land in his Peaceable Possession now
