doth by these presents grant Bargain and sell unto
the said John Myrick his Heirs and assigns for ever
a certain Tract or parcel of Land Lying and being in
Southampton County aforesaid & on the North side
Mehearin River & Bounded as followeth to wit) Begin
ing at a Hickory upon the Bank of the said River a
Corner of James Grecians Land thence by Grecians Line
North five Degrees East one hundred & thirty pole to
a White Oak the North Eighty five Degrees West one
hundred & sixty pole to an Elm then North fifteen Degrees
West ten pole to a White Oak a Corner of William Lees
Land thence by Lees Line North to a White Oak in the
Run of the Deep Creek thence North North West up the
Various Courses of the said Creek to an Elm a Corner
of John Petersons Land thence South two Hundred and
thirty pole to a Persimmon Tree by the side of the said
River thence down the Various Courses of the said River
to the first Station by the Reversion and Reversions
Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues & profits thereof
and also all the Estate Right Title Interest & Claim &
Demand whatsoever of them the said Thomas Barrow
