Vick This Indenture made this 12th Day of April in the year of
our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and fifty Between Arthur
Whitehead of Southampton County of the one parte and Jesse Vick
of the said County of the other Witnesseth that the said Arthur
Whitehead for and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said
Jesse Vick the receipt whereof the said Arthur Whitehead doth
hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained and sold aliene
in Infeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
Bargain and sell aliene Infeoff and Confirm unto the said Jesse
Vick a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of South
ampton aforesaid Containing by Estimation fore hundred and fifty
Acres be the same more or less the said divind of Land being a patent
granted to Arthur Whitehead aforesaid bearing Date the 13th Day
of October 1727 and bounded as followeth Beginning at the mouth
of the Rich neck branch on the south west side of Arthurs
Swamp thence up the various Courses of the run of the said
Branch west forty pole to a pine on the south side thereof thence
south twenty five Degrees East one hundred and twenty six pole
to a pine then South one hundred and fifty eight pole to a pine
then South Twenty five Degrees East one hundred Twenty six
pole to a pine then North seventy Degrees East one hundred and
sixty one pole to a small black oak then North twenty Degrees
East fifty fore pole to a pine then North twenty eight pole
to a pine by the side of the long branch then down the various
Courses of the run of the said branch to Arthurs Swamp

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
