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This Indenture Tripartite made the first Day of January in
 the Twenty third year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George
 the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland
 King Defender of the Faith &c and in the year of our Lord God one
 Thousand seven hundred & forty nine Between Sam Jack Will
 Frank John Turner, Watt Bailey Geo. Shipper chief Men of the Nottoway
 Indian Nation of the first part Joseph Gray & Thomas Jarrell of
 the second part and Thomas Westbrook of the County of Southamp-
 ton of the third part Whereas by an Act of Assembly made in the
 eighteenth year of his present Majesty intituled an Act to enable
 the Nottoway & Nansemond Indians to sell certain Lands and
 for other Purposes therein mentioned the Chief Men of the said
 Nottoway Nation were impowered with the Consent & Approbation
 of certain Trustees therein named to sell and convey for the use
 and Benefit of the said Nottoway Nation five Thousand Acres
 part of their Tract of six Miles Square lying between their western
 Boundary of their said Tract & Buckhorn Swamp on the south side
 of Nottoway River in the County of Isle of Wight (which part of the
 said County of Isle of Wight is since called Southampton) for the best
 price that could be got so as not to be under the Rate of twelve
 pounds ten Shillings for every hundred Acres and so that no part
 of the said Main Swamp be included within any such sale and

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
