

in Order to get the Price aforesaid the said Indians were obliged
to lay off the best of this said Lands in severals Parcels and the
remaining part of the Lands included in the Bounds aforesaid is
barren & of little or no use to the said Nation and lies in parcels
separate from each other and since the passing of the ^{said} Act the Num-
ber of the said Nation by Sickness & other Casualties are much
reduced for the better support and maintenance of themselves and
their Posterity and to enable them to pay their Debts by one other
Act of Assembly lately at Williamsburg made in the twenty
second year of the Reign of his present Majesty George the second
King of Great Britain entitled an Act to enable the Nottoway
Indians to sell certain Lands and for other Purposes therein
mentioned It was amongst other Thing enacted that the Chief
Men of the said Nottoway Nation be impowered by and with
the approbation of John Simmons Joseph Gray and Tho: Jarrell
Gentlemen the Survivors or Survivor of them (who were by the
said Act appointed Trustees to see the said Act duly executed)
to sell and convey the remaining part of the said Lands being
three thousand Acres or thereabouts lying between the western
Boundary of their said Land & Duckhorn Swamp aforesaid so
as not to include any part of the said Main Swamp for the best
Price that can be got & after any Agreement made for the Sale of
the same or any part thereof it shall and may be lawful for the
chief Men of the said Nation together with the Trustees aforesaid
or the survivors or Survivor of them to seal and deliver any Deed or
Deeds Indented for the Conveyance of the Fee Simple Estate & Inheri-
