Sum of our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and fifty Between Volentine
White of Brunswick County of the one part and Frances Laum of
Southampton County of the other part Witness that the said Volentine
White for an in consideration of the sum of Eighty five pounds
Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said
Frances Laum the Receipt whereof he Doth hereby Acknowledge
hath granted Bargained Sold A Line Infeoffed and Confirmed and
by these presents doth grant Bargain sell a Line Infeoff and confirm
unto the said Frances Laum his heirs and assigns for ever all that
Plantation and Tract or parcel of Land lying & being in Southampton
County Containing by Estimation three hundred and ninety Acres
more or less lying on the North side of the flat swamp being the
Land and Plantation where on the said Volentine White formerly
lived on which said Land being granted to John White father of the
said Volentine White by a Letter patten bearing date one thousand
seven hundred and twenty seven and the remainder part one hund
red fifty five Acres which by Letter patten was granted to Volentine
White bearing date June the sixteenth one thousand seven hund
red and forty four To have and to hold the said Land and
premises with the appurtenances unto the said Frances Laum
his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of the said Frances
Laum his heirs & assigns for ever and the said Volentine White

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
