by the said Frances Exum the Receipt whereof he doth hereby
acknowledge hath granted bargained Sold alien Infeoff and
Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
alien Infeoff and Confirm unto the said Frances Exum his
heirs and Assignes for ever all that Plantation and Tract or
parcel of Land lying and being in Southampton County
Containing by Estimation fifty Acres more or less and lying
