This Indenture made this 12th day of April Anno Dom: one thousand seven hundred and fifty Between Henry Blunt of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Blow of the aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Blunt for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the Insealing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt of which and himself fully Satisfied Contented and paid he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold a Liened and Confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell a Line and Confirm unto the said Samuel Blow his heirs and assigns for ever all that Tract or parcel of Lands lying and being in the aforesaid County and bounded as appears by a Deed from the Chief men of the Nottoway Indians to the said Henry Blunt dated the fourth day of April one thousand seven hundred and forty three and Recorded in the Court of Isle of Wight Preferrance thereunto being had will more fully and clearly appear also all woods
