Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Joseph
Jones before the sealing and Delivery hereof the receipt
whereof the said Walter & Benjamin Morrel doth hereby
acknowledge hath granted Bargained and sold and doth
hereby these presents grant Bargain and sell unto the
said Joseph Jones his heirs & assigns a Certain Tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton afores.
and on the South side of Black water Swamp containing
one hundred and seventy five acres part of a patent for
three hundred and fifty acres of Land granted to Tho^s Virby
the 13th day of November 1713 which said one hundred & seventy
five acres of Land was by the said Tho^s Virby sold and
Conveyed to Walter Walters and by the last will and
